The letters appear in the following sequence:

Even page numbers:

The pupils learn to write a letter of the alphabet by writing between the lines and writing over the letters and words. They recognize and identify small and capital letters.

Odd page numbers:

The pupils practise writing the letters and words on the 17mm lines.

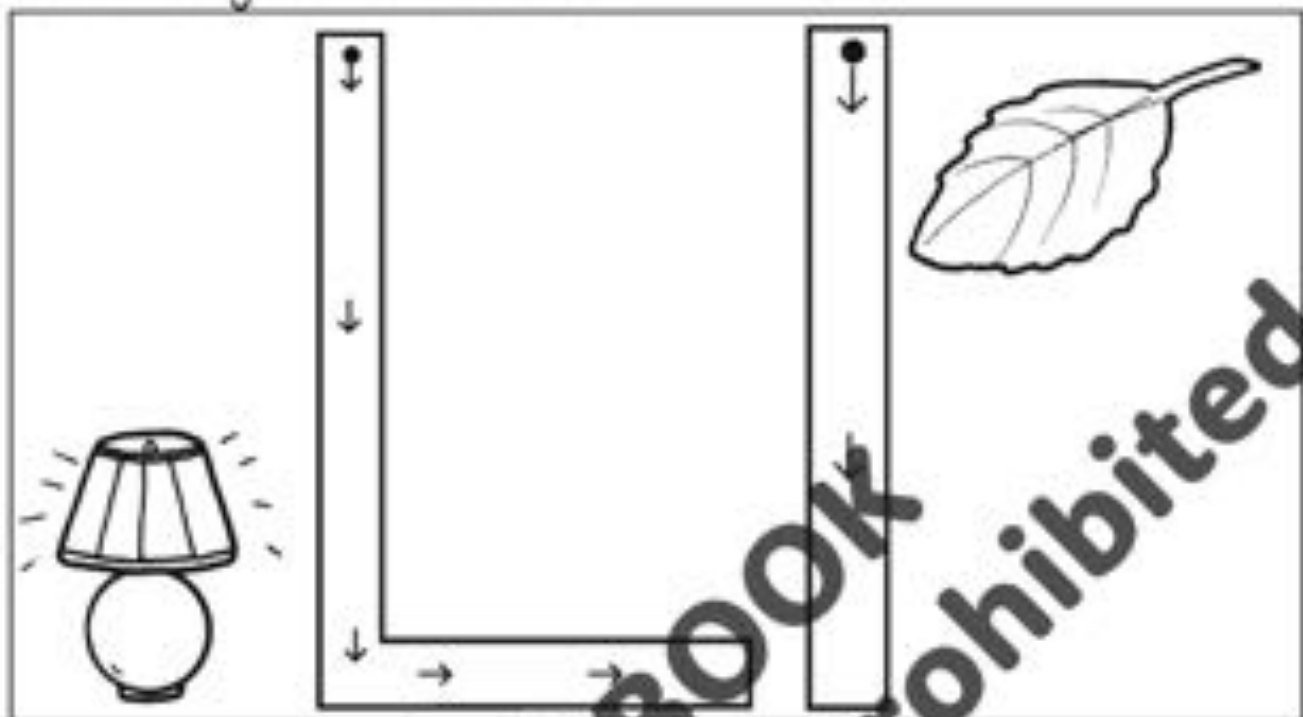
The activities also reinforce the following skills:

Recognition and identification of capital and small letters.
