## SOME RULES FOR JOINED-UP WRITING

The lettere should be close together with no spaces in between. Writing must sit on the line.


Writing must be of a uniform size - approx half the size of a standard line. (This book has used a size slightly larger than standard line, for practising purposes, but you can let the learners use standard lines at any time). The tops of the letters must not touch the top of the line above. The tops of the letters must not touch the top of the line above. The tops of slightly less than half-way down the space below. Capital letters are approx. 3/4 the size of the space between the lines. Searners who come from other schools who are already writing in cursive, should be allowed to continue doing so.
